



Mission of the project





Medical Abortion

Procedure that uses prescription pills to end a pregnancy in its early stages. It is nonsurgical and is considered safe and effective to use by the FDA up till 10 weeks of gestation. The legality of a medical abortion vary state by state. (Cleveland Clinic)

SOME REASONS WHY AN ABORTION MAY BE NECESSARY

Pulmonary Hypertension: Blood Pressure is too high which places a large strain on the body and can lead to heart failure

Cancer: Some treatments are not safe for pregnancy and someone may opt for an abortion to begin cancer treatment.

Ectopic Pregnancy: The fertilized egg implants outside the fallopian tube making it nonviable. If it ruptures it could lead to life threating internal bleeding Severe Kidney Disease:
